Title:	Member, ISTA Testing Council
Elected by:	Elected by the ISTA Testing Council
Length of Term:	Three (3) Years, may be elected to a second term
Reports To:	ISTA Testing Council
Expected Result:	An active Council that ensures ISTA remains the industry leader in pre-shipment performance testing and development

Specific Responsibilities:

The Member performs such duties as:

1. Attending and participating in and contributing to the Testing Council meetings. Attendance via phone is acceptable.

Action Steps
Understand the role of the Testing Council within the Association
Review agenda and supporting materials prior to Council meetings
Report on the results of committee activity if chairing the committee within the Council
Establish, review, and understand technical policies

2. Providing direction on the future of the Council

Action Steps
Suggest possible nominees to the Council who can make significant contributions to the work of the Council and Association
Make decisions in response to all proposals presented to the Council
Focus on issues where ISTA can play a positive role within the industry.

3. Electing the Chair of the Testing Council.
4. Serving on committees or task forces and offering to take on special assignments

Recommendations as to Qualifications:

- It is preferred that a Member is involved in the performing of ISTA testing
- It is preferred that a Member has CPLP certification

Commitment Required

- One on-site Testing Council meeting per year. The meeting is less than one day in length and the locations vary.
- One to three Testing Council teleconferences per year.
- Responding to emails, electronic ballots or possible participation in telephone conference calls regarding special events that may occur during the time period between Council meetings.
- Missing three or more consecutive ballots or meetings can lead to dismissal from the Council
